This 6th Annual Polar Bear Plunge will take place on Saturday, February 10th, 2024, at 1000, Lake Snowden, Albany, Ohio.
- Our objective is to raise money to benefit the Athens County Board of Developmental Disabilities for the children of Athens County. The ACBDD runs several programs that benefit children with disabilities, including: Early Intervention, Preschool, Beacon School, and Youth Employment Programs, along with Service & Support Services (also referred to as case management).
- 3. We ask that you include us in your charitable or philanthropic community support this year, we welcome your help and thank you for your generosity.
- 4. Proceeds that are generously awarded to the ACBDD will remain in Athens County and directly and positively

impact the children of Athens County. Specifically, the funds will be given to the Beacon School PTA. Proceeds this year will go toward the purchase of a motorized pool chair lift. This would give students a safer way for getting into and out of the indoor pool at Beacon School. Swimming is both a therapeutic and recreational activity for students. In addition to benefiting students, the pool chair lift could be utilized by community members who use the pool after hours. Groups of all ages and abilities use the pool for therapeutic and recreational needs. The cost for the lift and part of installation is expected to be \$10,000.00.
